Using ISO 56000 to Build Innovation into your Quality Management System

We live in a world of volatility, uncertainty, complexity and ambiguity. (It is often called VUCA!) Navigating this fast-changing world requires us to be agile and innovative. Businesses with the fastest profit growth have twice as much focus on innovation as their competition. Companies who are serial innovators have a system approach to innovation, and they continuously generate new ideas.

The Global Knowledge for an Innovation Management System (IMS) is in the new ISO 56000 series. ISO 56002 has the ISO High Level Structure which enables integration of ISO Management Systems and links to ISO 9001:2015. An effective Quality Management System (QMS) is the platform for an effective IMS. The standard is part of the ISO 56000 series and the requirements standard ISO 56001 will follow later. The IMS can thus be developed ahead of that publication.

In this presentation, Peter will explain the newly published IMS Guidance standard ISO 56002 and how to integrate it into a QMS. He will also share real world examples illustrating the clauses, from organizations such as Tesla, Netflix and IBM.

About the speaker: Peter Merrill is an innovation speaker and consultant who has keynoted at Innovation conferences in the Americas, Asia, Europe and the Middle East. His passion for Innovation comes from a lifelong practical experience. From his early years in Research and Development to being Chief Executive of a Designer Brand to enabling companies such as IBM, 3M and Blackberry develop their capabilities, he truly understands management systems and knows what innovation is about and how to achieve it.
